The Town Council of the Town of Iva met on Monday, December 12, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the Iva Town Hall, located at 204 E. Jackson Street. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Pro-Tem Powell called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Invocation was offered by Mr. Paul Hart. Following the Invocation, everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Mr. Frank Busterna commented to the Town Council regarding the need for security at the Iva Museum. Mr. Busterna commented that there is no phone system in the facility to call for help in case of an emergency. Mr. Busterna asked that the Town Council consider installing a phone system and asking the Iva Police to patrol more during the hours the Museum is open.

RESOLUTIONS FOR APPROVAL (First and Final Reading)

Resolution No. 2016-025 was presented for approval. Mr. Kelly made a motion to approve the Resolution, seconded by Mr. Hart. All were in favor. The vote was 4-0.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mayor Pro-Tem Powell commented that there was discussion of the Anderson County Sewer Contract. Legal advice regarding the contract was also received during the Executive Session.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR, TOWN COUNCIL & TOWN STAFF

Mr. Taylor commented on the following:

- Iva has been approved a PARD grant in the amount of \$10,000 to be used for East Lake Park/
- Iva has been approved for CDBG grant in the amount of \$323,585.00 for streetscape improvements on East Front Street and East Green Street.
- Iva received commemorative plaque from Tree City USA for achieving 30 consecutive years as "Tree City USA".
